Good Morning Gene:



Re: Emergency Medical Responder Refresher Program Review

The Registration Committee of the Alberta College of Paramedics (ACP) approved EMP Canada's Basic Life Support for Professionals EMR Refresher program on September 27, 28 & 29, 2000 as substantially equivalent to approved EMR Refresher programs in Alberta. Subsequently it was added to ACP's list of approved EMR Refresher programs.

The one-year program approval will be expiring in September 2001. Please submit all information regarding significant program content changes to the Registration Committee should these changes occur prior to the renewal date. If you would like to renew your program approval, the following information must be submitted to the Registration Committee for review by September 2001.

1. Number of students who have completed your program since the date of program approval;
2. Statistical report of all students who completed your program since the date of program approval (eg. 24 students enrolled, 20 graduates, 1 unsuccessful, 3 incomplete); and
3. Any program content changes implemented since the date of program approval.

Once the Committee has reviewed this information, it may:


- A. Recommend that the program be added to the EMT Regulation as an approved program;
- B. Extend the program approval for another one-year term; or
- C. Remove the program from ACP's list of approved programs.

The Registration Committee agreed that due to the 1999 AGM resolution requesting CMA accreditation for current approved programs and possible changes implemented by the Health Professions Act, that all EMR & EMT program renewals be subject to a one-year approval and that all EMT-P programs be subject to a one-intake term approval.

Please note that the ACP will not be submitting any additional reminders regarding program renewal. Should you have any questions regarding the above please contact our office.
